



## LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT

The ever-present yet still enigmatic **KQ** has been a constant presence in the Colorado theatre community for nearly five decades. Yet many would not know that he (it is believed) has directed more humans on Colorado theatre stages than anyone else.

**KQ** has credits in every theatre capacity but costuming. (And if you've seen his T-Shirts, you

*know why.)* But he is most proud to be joining the Colorado Theatre Guild's illustrious group of Lifetime Achievement Award winners as a teacher and as its first-ever techie.

**KQ** was born in Denver and has lived both an adventurous and mysterious life that includes five advanced degrees, living in a monastery for three years and a stint working as an underwater engineer in the Caribbean.

His first local stage credit was for setting lights and designing sound for Theatre Under Glass, but he has worked across the state, including at the Bonfils, New Denver Civic, Aurora Fox and StageDoor in Conifer.

He directed dozens of shows for the Original Scene, a longtime citywide, year-round theater company run by Catholic Youth Services, from 1978-93 with young actors including Broadway-bound Martin Moran, Mary Bacon, Rebecca Eichenberger, John Paul Almon, future film star John Carroll Lynch and local favorites Annie Dwyer, Jada Suzanne Dixon, Nick Sugar and John Moore.

Since 1984, **KQ** has been directing the massive annual Magic Moments jukebox musical, which gives up to 270 community members, some with disabilities, some not, to perform and commune together.

**KQ** was actively involved in efforts to start Denver School of the Arts and was among its first guest artists. His career highlight was directing "Our God's Brother," a play written by Pope John Paul II about the struggles of a Nazi-era Polish artist. It was seen by thousands at 1993 World Youth Day in 1993 in Colorado.

He is grateful for this award because of who it invites to the party. "Man, a techie is getting this thing," he said. "Isn't that just great?"
